- Seek assurance that our systems and our contractors' activities, systems and performance minimise the impact to our environment and that adequate training is provided to ensure that all individuals working on behalf of the company are competent in meeting required environmental standards.
- Create a culture where environmental incidents are reported, investigated, and shared openly to prevent reoccurrence.
- Support efforts to develop and implement new methods, procedures and technologies that have the potential to improve environmental performance.
- Engage with stakeholders in the development and implementation of forest management practices.
- Ensure that no trees are harvested or planted that have been produced by genetic modification.
- Commit to not offer or receive bribes of any description.
